City-wide Clean up: - Pls join the community for the 4th annual **city-wide clean up** on **Saturday April 13;** 9:30 am at the Thorold Library.

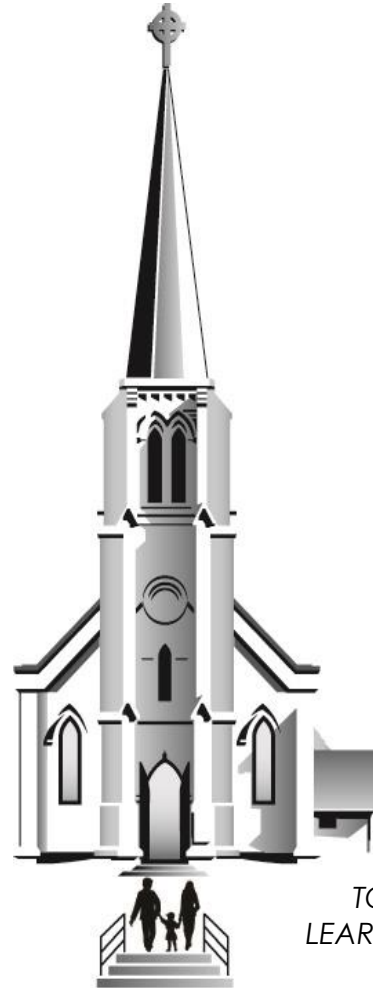
